a. WeGiveCatholic was a HUGE success for our Parish, School & Diocese raising over \$3,393,019 for hundreds of Catholic organizations in the Diocese! SFX School raised \$82,492 for furniture & flooring needs! With our Council's gift of \$1,000 set-aside, we gave \$100 for each 10 gifts over 120 from last year & so gave \$300 when they reached 140 between midnight & 6:00 AM! Boyd Watterson had a match of up to \$500 at 2:00 PM for \$25k until gone, with Tom Schmidt & Kevin Lynch getting us a doubling of our remaining \$700 to help raise a total of \$69,777 of the \$100,000 goal for the reno of the Church Basement Kitchen! 1. Parking Assistance (Andy Swancer) – Danene Beal, Principal of SFX School has requested parking assistance from the Knights on Tuesday, December 12 for the preschool Christmas Concert beginning at 630pm. GOOD OF THE ORDER (Brian Lombardi) -

Third Coming of Christ Excerpt from a sermon of St Bernard of Clairvaux

We know that the coming of the Lord is threefold: the third coming is between the other two and it is not visible in the way they are. At his first coming the Lord was seen on earth and lived among men, who saw him and hated him. At his last coming *All flesh shall see the salvation of our God*, and *They shall look on him whom they have pierced*. In the middle, the hidden coming, only the chosen see him, and they see him within themselves; and so their souls are saved. The first coming was in flesh and weakness, the middle coming is in spirit and power, and the final coming will be in glory and majesty.

This middle coming is like a road that leads from the first coming to the last. At the first, Christ was our redemption; at the last, he will become manifest as our life; but in this middle way he is our rest and our consolation.

7 O'Antiphons

Each text, in the original Latin, begins with the vocative particle "O". Each antiphon is a title of Christ, one of his attributes mentioned in Scripture. They are:

- 17 December: O Sapientia (O Wisdom)
- 18 December: O Adonai
- 19 December: O Radix Jesse (O Root of Jesse)
- 20 December: O Clavis David (O Key of David)
- 21 December: O Oriens (O Dawn of the East)
- 22 December: O Rex Gentium (O King of the Nations)
- 23 December: O Emmanuel

In the Roman rite, the O Antiphons are sung or recited at Vespers (Evening prayer)

Suggestions for 2024 Boost in your Spiritual Lives: Check out one of these 3 Catholic devotions.

Catechism in a Year (CIAY) -a 365 day devotion by Fr Mike Schmitz that daily examines all the Catholic Church teachings- great to do as a couple after dinner every night in 2024. Takes about 20 minutes per day.

Bible in a Year (BIAY)- same 365 day devotional format as CIAY but reads the entire Bible instead of the Catechism. Did you ever want to read the whole Bible cover to cover and understand it? Fr Mike Schmitz narrates the whole Bible and gives daily insights. About 45 minutes per day. I'm going to do BIAY in 2024 with my wife.

Exodus90- is a 90 day Catholic Men's devotion that focuses on three important transformative truths- Asceticism- Prayer- Fellowship. Starts on Jan 1st and ends on Holy Saturday 2024.
